## REQUIRED REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS

A birth certificate is required if:

- First time attending Summer at the Academy.
- Is not a current Norfolk Academy student.

A physical is required if:

- Not a current Norfolk Academy student (did not attend the 2022-2023 school year).

Not required if:

- If you attended Norfolk Academy for the 2022-2023 school year.

Your physical must include the immunization page and be less than 365 days old.

If you are a new incoming Bulldog for the 2023-2024 school year, and have already submitted to Admissions, please email Anita Pozin to confirm.

*Failure to submit required documents could result in forfeiture to attend Summer at the Academy.*

## CLOTHING

- Dress should be comfortable, and both weather and activity appropriate.
- Flip Flops, Crocs, open toed shoes and shoes not secured to the feet are not permitted.
- We strongly encourage all campers to apply sunscreen before arriving to camp, as all campers get moments in the sun. We cannot apply sunscreen to campers, but we will try to remind them to reapply (especially for outdoor camps).

## LOST & FOUND

- **PLEASE** label everything you send with your camper (towels, bathing suits, water bottles etc).
- Lost and found items will be held for a maximum two weeks before being donated. We are not responsible for lost items.
- We post "Lost and Found" alerts weekly on our IG page (NAHappyCamper)

## FOOD & DRINKS

- Lunch is included in all camps.
- Campers may also pack their own.
- Lunch menu will be online by June 1, 2023.
- Please email Anita Pozin if your child has special dietary needs.

## CANTEEN

- Is open from 9am-3pm for snack and drink purchases.
- Money may be sent on Monday to place on your campers "account" for the week. Any change will be sent home Friday.
- Money may also be sent daily with your child, but place it in a baggie or envelope with your child's name clearly printed on it.

## SWIMMING

- Included in most full day camps, and in most morning half-day Academy Day Camps.
- Is not included in afternoon half-day camps.
- Certified lifeguards are on duty at all times.
- Bring a labeled towel and bathing suit. Goggles are optional.
- Floatation devices are provided.





## TRANSPORTATION

- Bus service is included in registration.
- It's available on a first come, first serve basis.
- Please refer to pages 6-8 in the Summer Programs Brochure for complete transportation details.

***If your child's method of transportation has changed from the previous day or needs to change during the day, we must receive that change in writing!***

Please email Anita Pozin with this information.

Transportation lists are complete by 1 pm each day of camp, so to avoid confusion or anxiety for your camper, the sooner we can get this important information—the better.

## HEALTH & CLINIC

We have a registered nurse on campus from 8:45 am – 3:00 pm.

- Medications needed during camp must be brought to the clinic in their original containers.
- Must be brought to the clinic by a parent or guardian.
- Must be accompanied by documentation signed by a physician, indicating administration and dosage.

## AFTER/BEFORE CARE

- This program is a service provided for parents requiring extended care for their children.
- Before care opens at 7:30am.
- Aftercare closes at 6pm.
- Fees apply.
